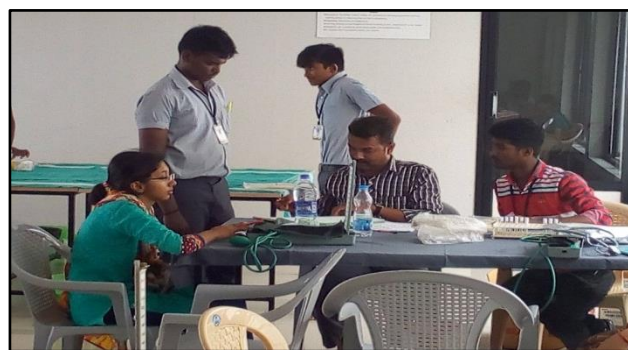

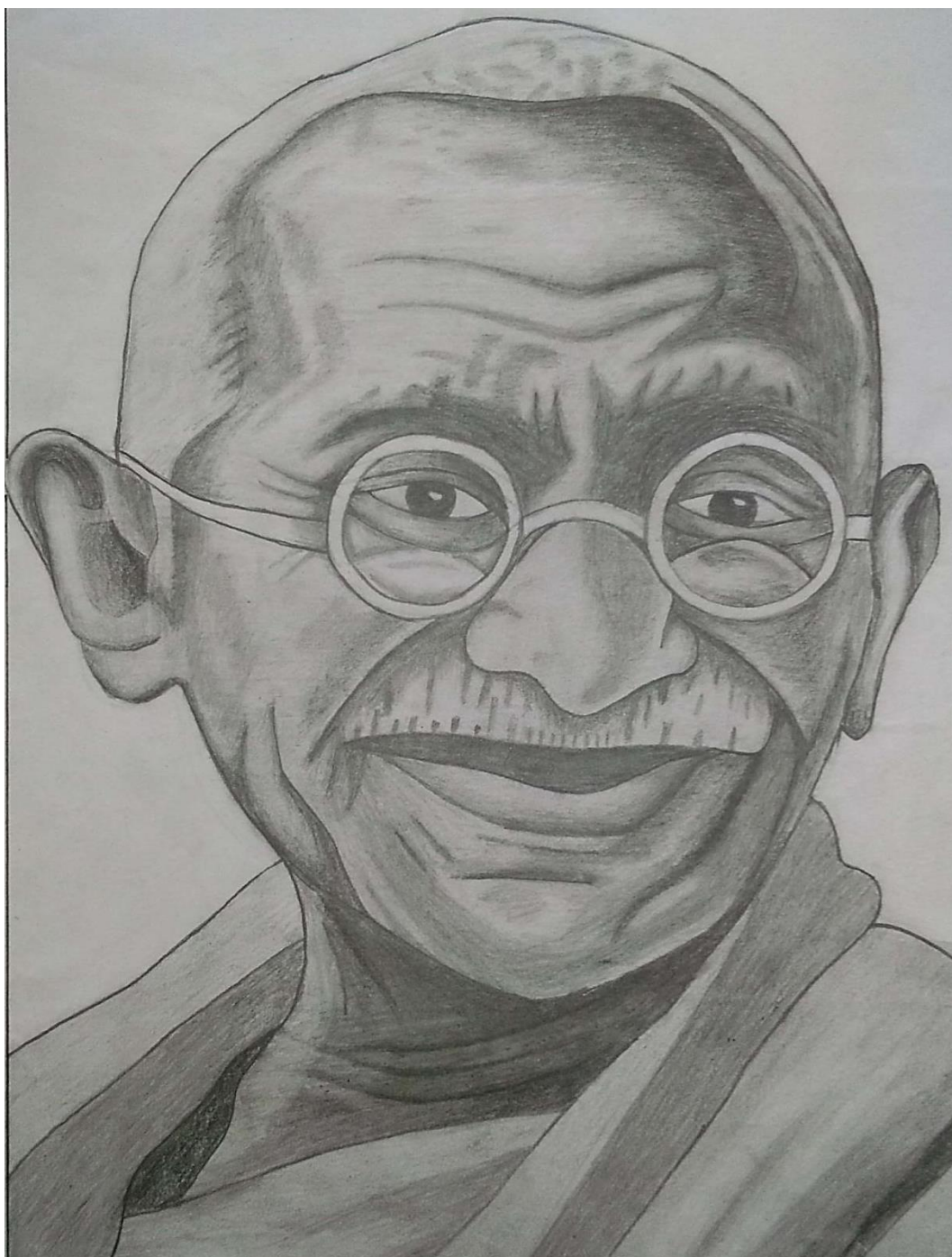
(Chief Guest address on “Eye Donate Awareness”)

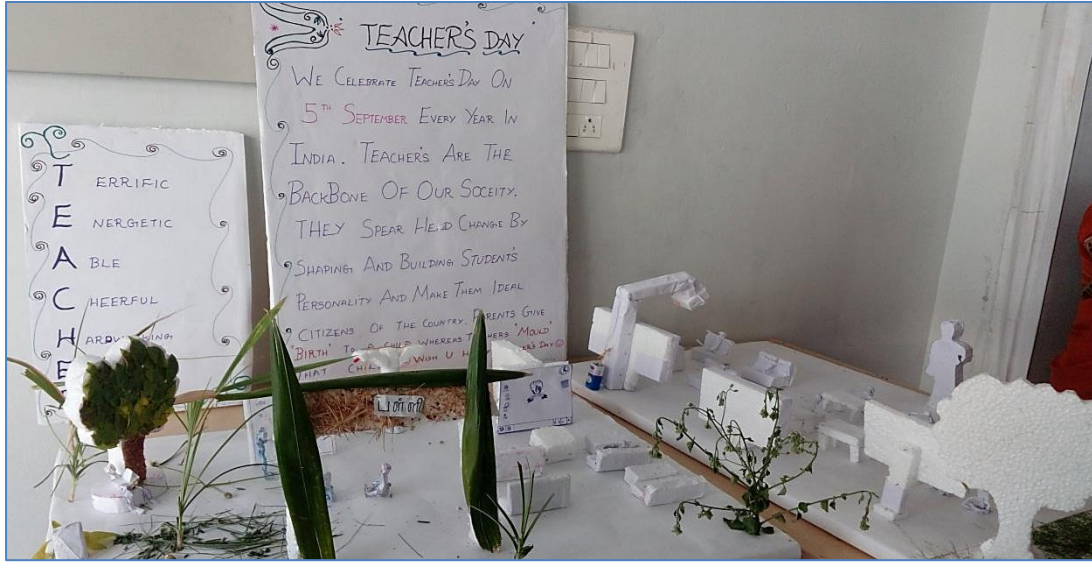

We are one of the fastest growing economies in today's world. Ironically we also shoulder the largest population of visually impaired.

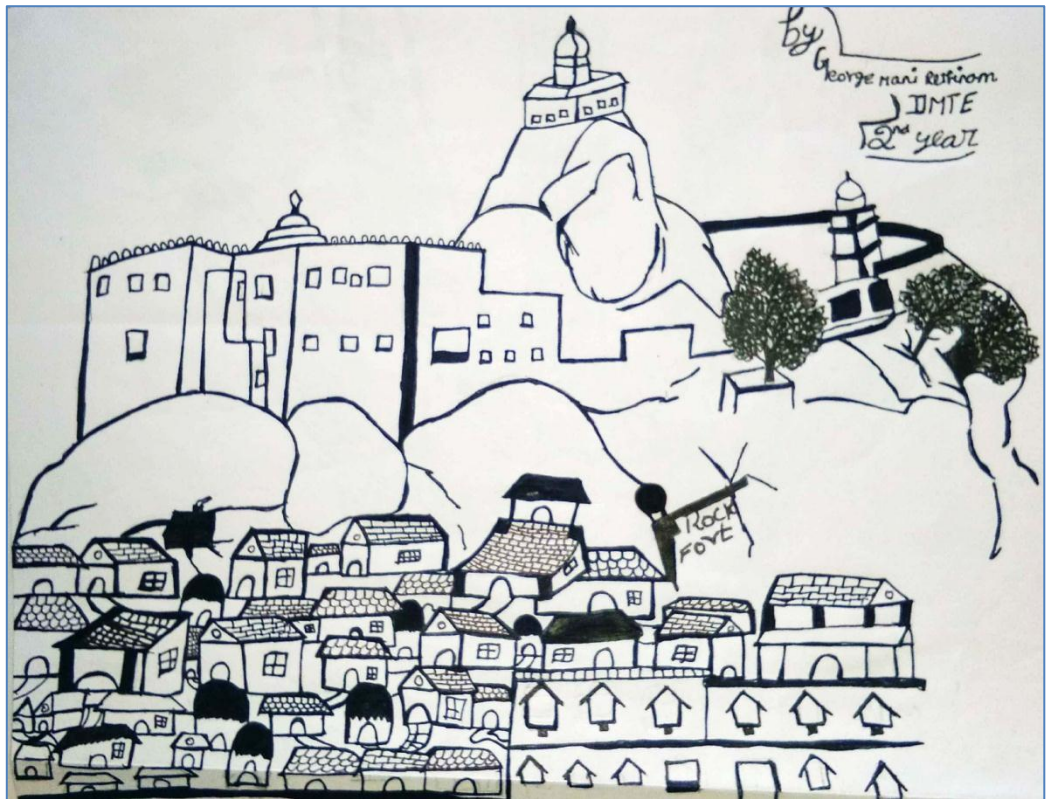
